## Annual Fire Safety and Sanitation Inspections

The Annual Fire Safety and Sanitation Inspections of each unit in Family Housing will be held in from Sept. 28-Oct. 8. Complete information regarding the types of issues we will be looking at and a schedule of the day we will be at your housing unit will be emailed to you in mid-September. Daily reminders and a 24-Hour Notice of Entry will also be delivered to your door at least 24 hours prior to your scheduled inspection. If violations are found you will be given an opportunity to correct the problem prior to an additional inspection, which will take place prior to November 30th.

As we go into September and October, the Saturday Market in downtown Eugene is still a great place to visit and shop for that uniquely Eugene item. The Farmer's Market on that site will also be bringing in the best of the seasonal bounty in organic veggies, bakery items, and some meats and eggs. The Saturday market moves indoors to the Lane County Fairgrounds in November and becomes the Holiday Gift Mart. Other events in September include the Eugene Celebration. This festival held downtown is another unique Eugene tradition. It includes music, food, arts, children's activities and a parade led by the "Slug Queen". Mountain Biking at Willamette Pass is a popular activity in the summer and fall. This winter time ski park is open now for mountain biking, hiking, and Frisbee golf.
