



Semester Calendar Addendum to the 2009–10 Residence Hall Contract

Because the Law School is on the semester calendar and the rest of the University is on the quarter calendar, certain adjustments must be made to accommodate semester student residents of University Housing. This Addendum to the University Housing Residence Hall Contract must be signed by the student and returned to University Housing along with the original Residence Hall Contract.

Charges are subject to approval by the State Board of Higher Education. Although, every effort is made to house semester students in a permanent residence hall upon arrival in August so that moves will be minimized, at this time it is not possible to guarantee permanent assignment in the initial location due to anticipated heavy housing activity during summer session. Please expect a possible room change in mid-September.

Fall semester residents may remain in their rooms until December 16 at 7:00 p.m. The dining halls are closed beginning December 11 at lunch. Custodial Services will begin vacation staffing patterns on December 12. During periods when residence halls and dining operations are normally closed, services available to semester residents will be reduced.

Actual meal times prior to September 24, 2009 may vary from those listed in other publications.

2009–10 Pre-Contract Arrival Charges

The Semester Contract starts on August 16, 2009. Only those students who are REQUIRED by a University Department (i.e., the Law School) to arrive prior to August 16 may arrive prior to the contract start date. Your contract will then start on the day you check-in. Pre-contract arrival rates will apply as indicated in the Residence Hall Supplemental Forms.

2009–10 Miscellaneous Semester Contract Changes

Interim Breaks (refer to the *2009–10 Residence Hall Contract*, page 5):

Winter Interim Break (December 16, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. through January 3, 2010): the charge is \$204 for a standard room and \$323 for a Barnhart room.

Spring Interim Break (March 21, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. through March 28, 2010): the charge is \$108 for a standard room and \$171 for a Barnhart room.

Room and Board Payment Schedule

2009–10 Academic Year

University Housing uses a Semester Payment Plan with monthly payments which includes the \$250 prepayment due with fall semester offers. Spring semester applicants do not pay the \$250 prepayment.
